## Care and support

Your care is based on what is important to you. We will partner with you and your loved ones to ensure the care you receive meets your needs and wishes.

We aim to provide you with peace of mind, comfort and proactive care during this time. You and your family will be supported by our dedicated and specialist trained staff as well as:

- A specialist GP consultant
- A palliative care nurse
- A 24-hour registered nursing team
- Allied health professionals.

O'Neill House also has a dedicated pastoral care service offering spiritual and emotional care to you and your family. They are supported by a team of dedicated volunteers who will offer practical support every day.

## Your personal space

This building has been redesigned following extensive research, recognising the importance of the physical environment. All rooms promote independence and mental wellbeing through the use of light, nature and luxurious finishes to make your stay complete.

Every room includes:

- A generous king single bed
- A beautifully appointed ensuite bathroom
- A flat-screen television and Wi-Fi
- Climate control with the ability to open windows and doors for fresh air
- Ample robes, shelving and storage to display and store your personal items.

A family member or friend is welcome to stay overnight with their loved one at any time. We also offer a fully self-contained apartment where extended family can stay for a fee.





## Services

O'Neill House is located in the heart of Prahran, giving you and your family easy access to enjoy this vibrant area, including Victoria Gardens, local cafes and pubs.

We also provide a range of onsite, fee-based services including:

- Beauty therapy and hairdressing

## Access eligibility and fees

To be eligible for this service you must qualify for an aged care assessment and income testing. Your GP, palliative service or hospital can guide you through this process.

If you do not wish to undertake these assessments, a full fee for service is required.
