CCCG provides unwavering support for marginalised older men with histories of homelessness, addiction or complex health needs. We offer more than just a place to reside; we provide an opportunity for a fresh start in a safe and supportive environment.

Our dedicated team collaborates with residents to celebrate their intrinsic value and contributions, ensuring all are embraced for their unique qualities.



Our history

Founded in 1974 by Mother Teresa and her Missionaries of Charity, Corpus Christi Community Greenvale was established as a refuge for men facing personal hardships.

In 1977, the Missionaries of Charity entrusted the care of Corpus Christi Community Greenvale to the Archdiocese of Melbourne. The Australian Jesuits, in collaboration with the Sisters of Mercy, were invited by Church leaders to manage the residence. These dedicated priests and nuns, along with volunteers, lived alongside and provided unwavering support to the residents.

With the principles of personcentred care underpinning all that we do, our aim is to provide exceptional assistance and support, ensuring that residents are treated with utmost dignity and respect.

- Experienced nursing and support staff to oversee resident care and wellness
- Nutritionally balanced meals to promote health and vitality
- Alcohol support program for residents seeking assistance to cease or minimise alcohol consumption
- Onsite medical clinic where you can access a range of medical specialists including doctors, psychologists, physiotherapists, podiatrists and counsellors
- Spiritual guidance and pastoral care if you seek support, guidance and confidential companionship.



Lifestyle and recreation

Our lifestyle and activities are designed to foster connections with staff, volunteers and fellow residents. Enjoy a range of activities including gardening, games, bingo, dancing, arts and crafts and in-house movies. We also offer regular excursions to interesting locations across Melbourne and Victoria.

Beyond recreation, we provide opportunities for residents to contribute their skills to local charities and community groups, plus lending a hand with various duties within CCCG.

Admissions

Corpus Christi Community Greenvale welcomes admission enquiries from individuals, families and friends, along with referrals from aged care, mental health, hospital, homeless, and community services. Funded places support older men in need, while unfunded places cater to those seeking independent living with minimal care needs. Respite and palliative care are also available.

To be considered for admission, applicants should meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Male gender
- Eligibility for an Aged Care Assessment
- Typically over 60 years of age
- · Marginalised or homeless background
- Experiencing personal support needs
- Desire to live within a nurturing and supportive environment.
